Dear KPIS Community,

It is unfortunate that we have to announce that our kindergarten student has tested positive for covid-19. We wish him well in his recovery as he is now in hospital with his father as per Ministry of Public Health protocol.

To better understand the following timeline, the family has allowed us to share that the parents live in separate homes and share custody of the children. The child was either at the father's condo or at his mother's home.

Timeline

- **March 26- 28** The child stayed with his father at his condo.
- **March 29-April 2** (evening) The child stayed with his mother at her home.
- **April 2-4** On PTC day, April 2, the child did not come to school and stayed with the mother's family at her home. He was later dropped off at his father's condo at 9.30pm on April 2. The child stayed with his father* at his condo over the weekend.
- **April 5** The child did not come to school (quarantine at mother's home with family).

*Father had close contact with a confirmed covid positive carrier (who had been exposed in the Thonglor/Ekamai area) on March 31 and April 2. **The child did not meet with his dad until after these two contact exposures.**

We would like to reassure the school community, especially the Kindergarten, that **at no point was the child on campus with other members of the KPIS community after his first point of contact exposure.** This means that the level of risk to the community from this case is very low, and at a Third Degree of Separation ([as per our previous email](#)).

Please keep abreast of further information and updates regarding the current campus closure at the school. As always, we encourage you to keep safe and aware of the news regarding the virus in the wider community, avoiding high risk areas, practicing social distancing and mask wearing, and adhering to protocols wherever you go.

Thank you for your continued support, concern, and understanding as we navigate this challenging time together as a community.
