Main Duties and responsibilities:

- Manage classroom responsibilities and implement school procedures.
- Work with other teachers and school administrators to achieve academic goals.
- Create daily, weekly, and yearly lesson plans that are engaging, productive and valuable for students.
- Administer, grade, and report in-class assessments in addition to pre-determined, standardized exams using the KPIS Standards-Based Grading system.
- Select reading, writing and other curriculum-development materials, including textbooks, in accordance with grade level expectations and goals.
- Meet one-on-one with students to improve performance; hold conferences with parents and guardians as needed.
- Watch closely for students who are struggling with emotional problems, learning disabilities or situations at home, and help them find the resources they need.

Other Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide formal students supervision during scheduled supervision times
- Act as a substitute teacher for teachers who are absent, as needed
- Other duties, as assigned by school leadership

- Effective at speaking in front of groups, both children and adults, and accomplished at inspiring children to learn.
- Willing to contribute positively to the implementation of school initiatives and a positive school culture
- Managing classrooms with diverse students and different learning abilities.

- Experts in reading and writing, vocabulary and mathematics curriculum, and other subjects for kindergarten students.
- Consistent and present in all students' lives. Young students thrive on regular schedules, so keeping with a set routine is important for all teachers.
