**Dear KPIS Community,**

This is the short weekly announcement to update you on the recent cases within the community:

- 1) **For the positive case** in Grade 1 reported to the school on May 8, the student is in home isolation and will return to campus once cleared to do so
- 2) **For the positive case** in KG Whales reported to the school on May 9, the student is in home isolation and will return to campus once cleared to do so. A Grade 2 student is in isolation as a household close contact as a result.
- 3) **For the household close contact case** in Nursery reported to the school on May 10, the student will remain in home-isolation until cleared to return.
- 4) **For the household close contact case** in Grade 4 reported to the school on May 10, the student will remain in home-isolation until cleared to return
- 5) **For the household close contact case** in Grade 6 reported to the school on May 11, the student will remain in home-isolation until cleared to return
- 6) **For the positive case** in Grade 7 reported to the school on May 16, the student is in home isolation and will return to campus once cleared to do so. The student was last on campus on May 11.

In all cases, the parents of affected grade levels have been contacted directly via email, LINE or Seesaw from the school so that appropriate response following protocol can be taken. Furthermore, communication from families and staff involved has been proactive in helping us work together to manage each case, keeping the risk to the community low.
